#### History

Gus R. Wood built this seven room brick house for his own use

during 1938-9<sup>1</sup>. The cost was estimated at 1,447 pounds. Isaac Greenburg replaced him within two years as owner- occupier, possibly indicating Wood's speculative intent<sup>2</sup>.

### Description

A prototype of the notorious multiple fronted brick veneer, this Moderne styled house shows its period by the stuccoed streamlining of its curved corners and the use of metal frames for its windows. Its hipped roofs overhang the walls to a greater extent than its Italianate forbearers and its windows are slots instead of slits but otherwise the asymmetrical facade and general plan form dates back to the 19th century.

This house is enhanced by its period garden and intact front fence.

## Streetscape


Contributing part of an important residential precinct.

# Significance

Architecturally, a near original example of a typical suburban style which contributes to an important villa precinct: of regional interest and local importance.

Historically, little is known of Wood in the Camberwell context except as a probable speculative builder in the new post-war estates.

#### History

Annie Ladd, a merchant, commissioned builder, J.P. Spargo to construct over 19 squares and eight rooms of brick household, at an estimated cost of £1,850<sup>1</sup>. The house was built on the Golf Links estate.

B. Williams owned the house by the late 1930's as did A.J. Sewell in the 1950's<sup>2</sup>.

### **Description**

This is a conservative Mediterranean villa, with its textured stucco walls, hipped and tiled roofs, and flashes of heeler brickwork placed at strategic points around the walls. Approaching the typical multi-fronted brick veneer of the 1950's, the house is greatly enhanced by its siting, iron details, original fence, typical period colour scheme and empathetic garden. The columnar cypress are particularly appropriate for the Italian or Mediterraneanvilla garden.

#### Significance

Architecturally, an intact example of a popular villa style which is a key element to the important Golf Links estate: of regional interest and local importance.

Historically, Ladd appears typical of the initial merchant and professional classes which occupied the estate: of local interest.
