25 GLENLEITH AVENUE

HISTORY

This house was built in 1912-13 for Thomas Clarke (retired) and was described as weatherboard, six rooms, bathroom and wash house. By 1920 John Cuddihy was listed and the resident.

DESCRIPTION

It is a single storey timber house clad in weatherboards and the roof is clad in corrugated iron. It is Edwardian in style and it has an excellent degree of integrity. It is notable for its decorative elements in particular, the superb bow windows and fine leadlighting. The verandah valance is adorned with timber fretwork and the roof has elaborate ridge decoration. The garden layout appears to be contemporary with the house.

SIGNIFICANCE

25 Glenleith Avenue is an Edwardian house with elaborate decorative elements. It has an excellent degree of integrity and it is of local significance.
