BUILDING CITATION

This building was constructed for the Y.M.C.A. in 1908 to the design of Architects, Barlow Molloy and Chandler. Alfred Deakin laid the foundation stone on 17th July 1908.

The design of the building is somewhat clumsy. The corner turret surmounted by pepper-pot dome provides a degree of interest. The oriel window to the side elevation with delicate lead lighting breaks up a large unpainted facade.

The building provides a strong corner streetscape component. It is in good condition is relatively intact, and is of local importance.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that this building be added to the Register of the National Estate, and be specified under Clause 8 of the Town and Country Planning Act (Third Schedule).
