

No. 38 'Havilah', Brick Cottage, 406 Simpson Street.



This cottage is distinguished by a battlemented parapet which lines the front facade. Otherwise a simple cottage with an unusual curved post-supported verandah around three sides.

No. 39 'Kings Hill', 104 Simpson Street.



A single storey brick residence erected in the 1850s for Thomas Sheppard, who established a brewery at the rear of his property. A post-supported bullnose verandah features cast iron work.

No. 40 Timber Cottage, 2 Warrenheip Street.



A small timber cottage with corrugated roof and front verandah. It is devoid of decoration.
