

No. 25 Brick Cottage, 405 Learmonth Street.



This brick residence was constructed in c. 1870, and a former occupation is locally reported to be a school. The building is now a combined commercial premises and residence. A timber post supported verandah completes the building to the street facades.

No. 26 Brick House, 407 Learmonth Street



This imposing two-storey residence was constructed for Dr F R Longden in c. 1880 to the design of architect, Clegg. An architectural drawing of the building is held in a private collection. The residence is constructed on brick with a slate roof. The building facades are articulated by horizontal bonding, and the principal facade is completed by a post supported verandah.

No. 27 f. National Bank of Australasia, 319 Learmonth Street.



The National Bank of Australasia commenced operations in Buninyong as an agency under the management of Mr S Worth. Early banking activities were undertaken within Thomas Adams' Post Office, Store. In 1859, Crown Allotment 1 of Section 9 was purchased from Adams, however the present bank building was not constructed until 1866, for the contract sum of 2,184 pounds. The architect for the bank and premises is not known.

The bank is constructed of brick with a slate roof and comprised a Banking Chamber, Managers Residence of six rooms, kitchen and servants quarters.
