

HISTORY : Probably built about 1875.

VISUAL DESCRIPTION : A single-fronted, hip-roofed Victorian simple timber cottage.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS : Comparable to : 122 Corsair Street (ref : 180); 32 Corsair Street (ref : 57) and 8 Dickens Street (ref : 49).

SIGNIFICANCE : A characteristic Victorian timber cottage of architectural interest at local level.

INTACTNESS : Evidence of early colour scheme is lost.

CONDITION & THREATS : Good.
