

HISTORY : Built about 1870.

VISUAL DESCRIPTION : A two-storey shop with residence. It has tripartite round headed windows with string-course mould, frieze and cornice, between plain corbels. The parapet centrepiece is arched and supported by scrolls. Two unpainted render chimneys and one brick. The return is set well back.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS : Comparable shops are 202-206 Church Street (ref : 156) and 96-98 Victoria Street (ref : 111).

SIGNIFICANCE : A characteristic shop with residence of about 1870, of local architectural interest.

INTACTNESS : Fair. Lacks ground-storey front, Render has been stripped, the verandah is a recent replica and lacks urns.

CONDITION & THREATS : Good.
