HISTORY: Built about 1870.

<u>VISUAL DESCRIPTION</u>: A two-storey shop with residence. It has tripartite round headed windows with string-course mould, frieze and cornice, between plain corbels. The parapet centrepiece is arched and supported by scrolls. Two unpainted render chimneys and one brick. The return is set well back.

<u>COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS</u>: Comparable shops are 202-206 Church Street (ref: 156) and 96-98 Victoria Street (ref: 111).

<u>SIGNIFICANCE</u>: A characteristic shop with residence of about 1870, of local architectural interest.

INTACTNESS : Fair. Lacks ground-storey front, Render has been stripped, the
verandah is a recent replica and lacks urns.

CONDITION & THREATS : Good.
