KANE'S BRIDGE, YARRA BEND NATIONAL PARK ...
YARRA RIVER

Little is known of this timber pylon, suspension bridge except that it was rebuilt after the 1934 floods. Its present form resembles the earlier bridge which crossed from the Yarra Bend Asylum to Kew, further upstream. Name's Bridge is of a picturesque design unmatched by any other in the Metropolitam area.
