What is significant?

The Aboriginal Health Service, on the former Exhibition High School site at 186 Nicholson Street, Fitzroy, was created in 1991 for the Aboriginal Health Service. The former Exhibition High School on this site was demolished in 1991. The place has a good integrity to its creation date.

Fabric from the creation date at the Aboriginal Health Service, former Exhibition High School site is locally significant within the City of Yarra, compared to other similar places from a similar era.

How is it significant?

The Aboriginal Health Service, former Exhibition High School site at 186 Nicholson Street, Fitzroy is historically and architecturally significant to the locality of Fitzroy and the City of Yarra.

Why is it significant?

The Aboriginal Health Service is significant as an important institution for the Aboriginal community and a notable piece of Modernist architecture (see Wight 2001).
