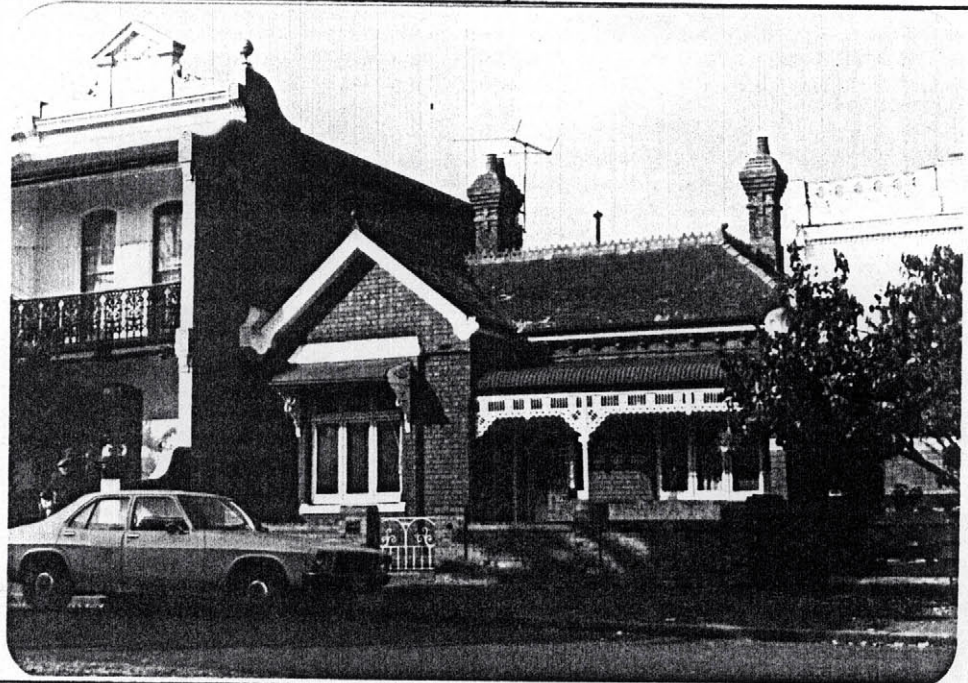

- fenestration intact
- unpainted cement render CHITLINS
- unpainted decorative brickwork
