The building is made up of a main hipped roof section, with a central projecting gable and a later hipped roof extension to the north-west. The north elevation bullnosed verandah has a separate roof clad in corrugated iron, with decorative turned timber posts, brackets and fretwork. The two double-hung timber frame windows and the central timber door on the north elevation appear to be original. The projecting gable has a scrolled finial, plain timber bargeboards, and a central aluminium frame window. The newer extension to the west also has an aluminuim framed window.
