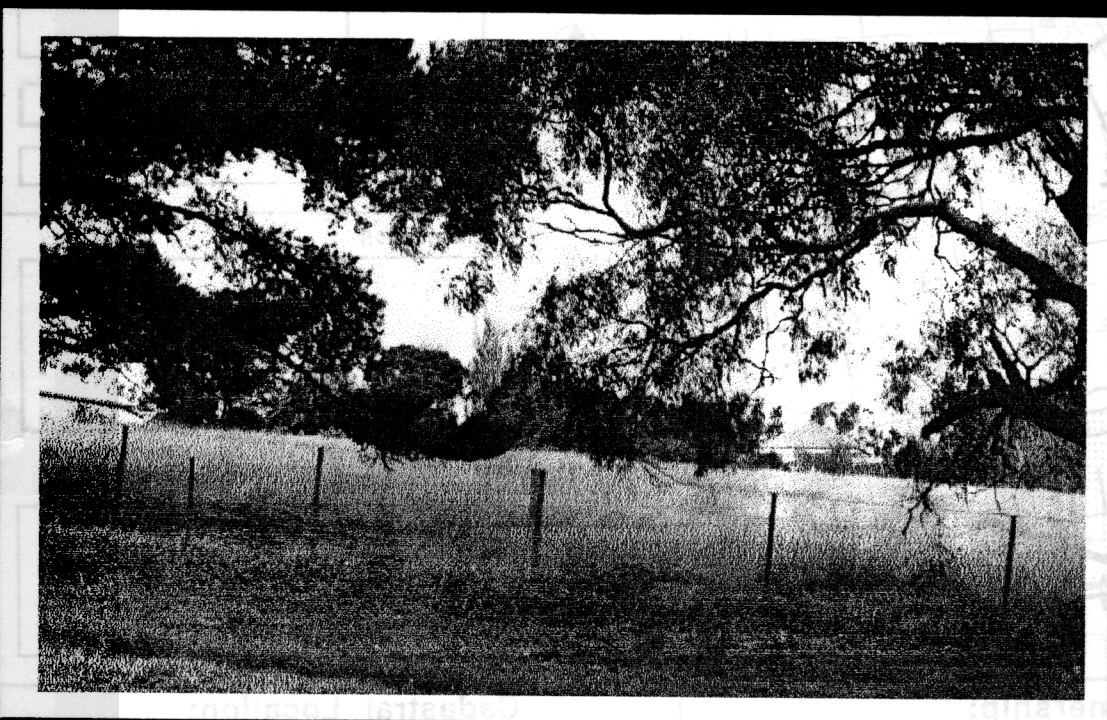

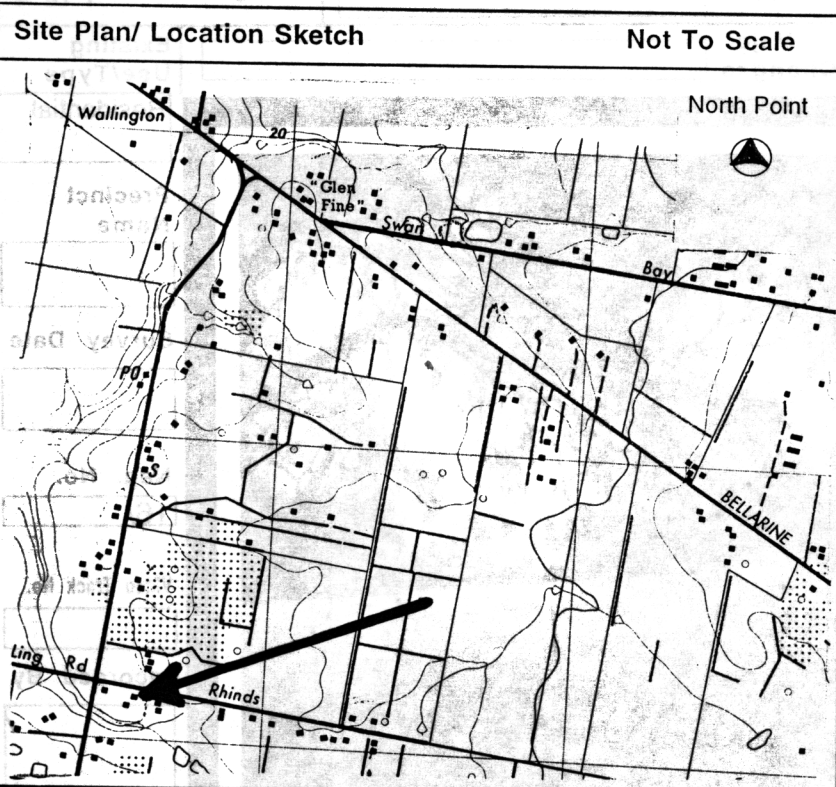

History of Site/Object/Place:

Anecdotal evidence suggests that this small brick cottage may be the oldest building in the Wallington district. It is believed to have been built from bricks that were made on the site.(1)

Local recollections have revealed that the cottage was owned at various times by the following: Alfred Sutterby, Doctor Small, Albert Brooking, Jack Duffield, Allan Duffield and Max Lamb.(2)

The Geelong Advertiser 3.1.1881 records that Sutterby's property 640 acres approx, 1 mile from Wallington 4 roomed brick cottage, orchard, vineyards, wine cellars etc., to be let with vacant possession (3)

Sands and McDougall directory 1918 lists Albert E. Brooking, 1939 lists Thos. H. Duffield farmer and 1949 and 1958 lists Allan C Duffield farmer.(4)

Statement of Cultural Significance:

'Carinya' is a solid brick cottage, built in the early settlement period and with good integrity.

It is of historic and scientific significance to the local Wallington community.

'Carinya' is of historic significance as it is probably the oldest building in the Wallington area and is believed to be built of bricks made on the site. Originally the homestead on a 640 acre selection used to grow vines and fruit trees, it represents the scale and activities of farming in the area. The use of local materials to construct the house is of scientific interest.

It is of **LOCAL** cultural significance.
