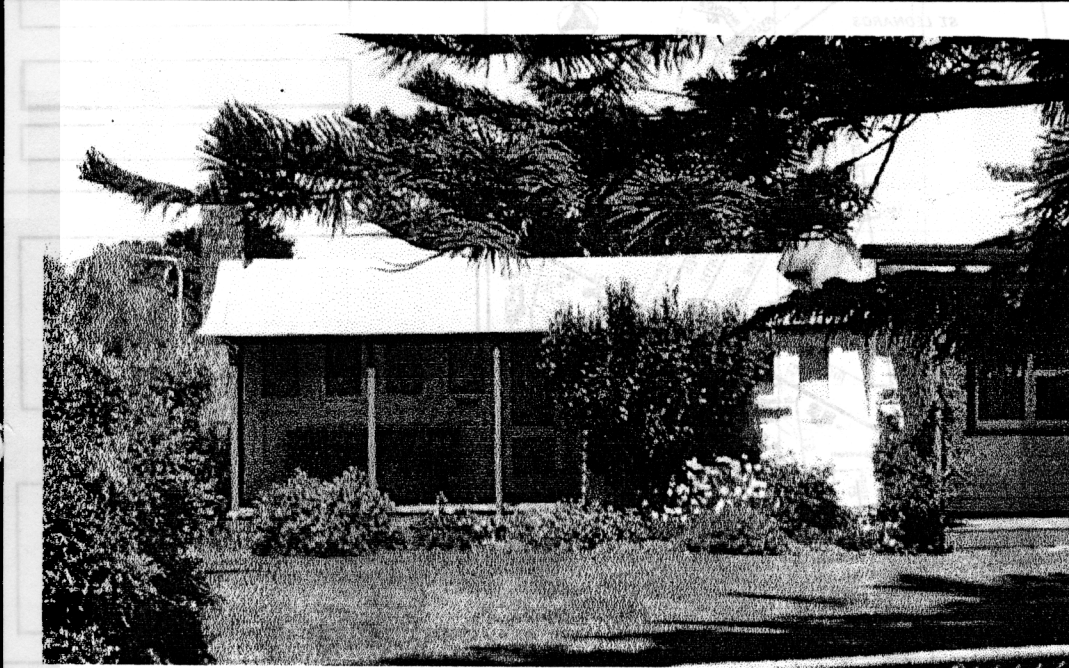

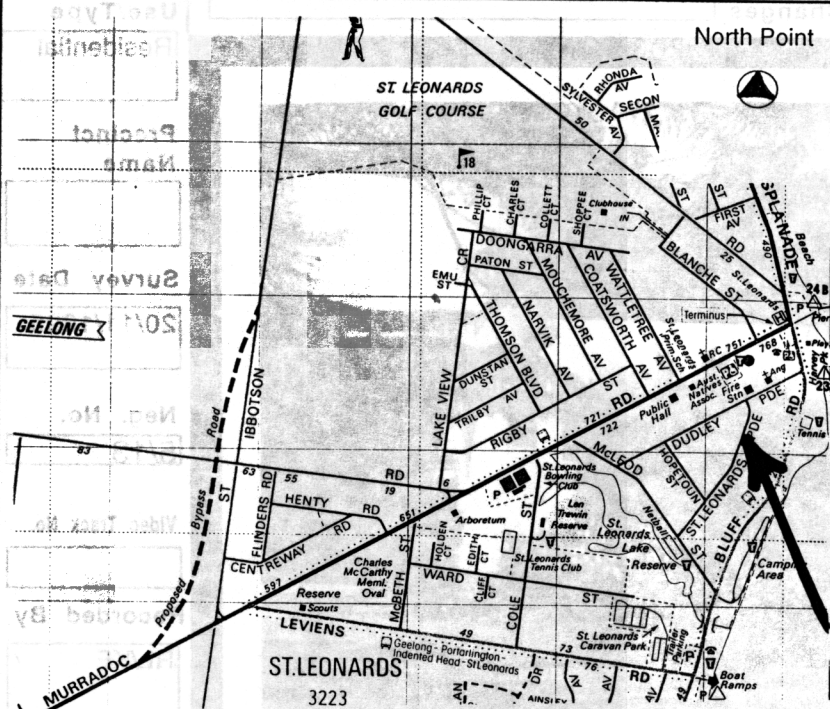

Statement of Cultural Significance:

Edina Cottage incorporates part of the bay steamer *Edina*. The north west elevation is a portion of the cabin from the vessel and is in good condition.

Edina Cottage is of historic value to the community of the Bellarine Peninsula.

Edina Cottage incorporates a portion of one of the most significant maritime vessels to ply its trade as a passenger and cargo carrier between Geelong, Portarlington and Melbourne. The *Edina* was an integral part of the Bellarine Peninsula's maritime history. Captain Forbes who had captained the ship for many years, salvaged part of it as a cabin at his Indented Head home. After his death it was incorporated into this house at St Leonards.

It is of **LOCAL** cultural significance.
