### Statement of Cultural Significance:

The Portarlington Cemetery is located south west of the town on a hill and contains the graves of many district pioneering families. It is organised in Wesleyan/Methodist, Church of England, Roman Catholic and Presbyterian denominational sections with headstones dating from the 1850's. Some of the large ornamental groves of trees have commemorative significance.

The Portarlington Cemetery has scientific, historic and social value to the surrounding district.

The Portarlington Cemetery headstones and memorials are a source of genealogical information and examples of monumental mason craftsmanship. The size and decoration of the memorials indicating the status of the individual or the family and the location and layout of the Cemetery make this an important cultural place.

It is of LOCAL cultural significance.
