Description

A row of mature, exotic trees associated with a fine Victorian building, Mononia.

Remnant Fabric (Man Made)

The street frontage to the property is bounded by an imposing iron fence, which appears to be an original garden feature. The fence is set on a basalt plinth. The entry gates are a modern accretion.

Remnant Fabric (Vegetation)

The site is dominated by a row of mature Bhutan Cypress (Cupressus torulosa), which form an effective screen to the property. The screen may be an overgrown clipped hedge. The balance of the landscape on the site is modern in character.

Potential Threats

Removal of the trees or iron fence.

Management Steps

Inform the owners as to the importance of these plantings, and seek their assistance in the trees' ongoing conservation.

Statement of Significance

The Bhutan Cypress' are of local interest as rare survivors of original plantings associated with a Victorian terrace house. The trees provide a contemporary setting to the building, and form a local landmark. They contribute significantly to the amenity of the local neighbourhood.
