## HISTORY

The house was built circa 1885 and it is called 'Glendon'.

## DESCRIPTION

The single storey, predominently red brick house exhibits many features of Late Victorian architecture. These include the asymmetrical front elevation, polychrome brickwork, banded slatework, fine detailing on the cast iron-columns, brackets and frieze and elaborate window and door decoration. The decorative brackets either side of the front entrance are of particular note. Other elements of note are the original roof form, tuckpointed brickwork, eaves decoration and the tiled and slate edged verandah.

#### SIGNIFICANCE

'GLENDON' is a Late Victorian red brick house which is unusual in Geelong West. It has an excellent degree of intregrity. It is of local significance.
