The asymmetrical front elevation has a vernadah with a convex roof and curved decorative timber brackets. The front bay contains a ripple iron hood above a tripartite timber-framed, double-hung sash window. The house is occupied but quite neglected. The hood over the front-gable window is almost falling off and the house is unpainted. A row of seven mature trees along the west boundary of the property have recently been chopped down.
