Description

Bay fronted timber villa with a return verandah. building is made more prominent by its wide garden and corner allotment. The external form is not common in More usually timber buildings only have a verandah at the front. Similar buildings could be found in Brunswick, Canterbury and Camberwell.

The interior is notable for its substantial intactness including original woodgraining to joinery.

Alterations

New fence; new verandah floor; verandah iron, posts and fascia may be later renovation.

Unsympathetic additions

New colourbond roof; verandah roof not rolled (skillion).

Whilst the building occupies a corner and is prominent in the street, it appears to have a number of non original elements which are sufficient to downgrade from an otherwise C to a D. The interior includes significant finishes however, which on balance require an increase in grading to C.
