History

"Wanda" was constructed in 1910⁴⁵ and by 1918 was occupied by Thomas M. Burke. By 1925, John F. Brady, agent, was listed as owner/occupier of a brick house of nine rooms, NAV 145 pounds. Brady was owner/occupier still in 1931-32, when "Wanda's" NAV was 125 pounds. Occupied in 1961 by Sir Henry Wardlaw, 57 Kinkora Road has recently been extended and renovated in recent times.
