History

Mrs. Elizabeth Mollison was the first owner/occupier in 1887-88 of the substantial double-storeyed brick residence in a garden setting known now as 518 Glenferrie Road. The property was described the following year as an eleven-roomed brick house, still owned by Mrs. Mollison. By 1893, No. 197 Glenferrie Road (as the property was then known) was the home of Alexander Gillespie, gentleman, and was listed as a nine-roomed brick house. 38
