Statement of Significance

The Uniting Church Hall, 25 Highbury Grove, is significant as a distinctive example of late Victorian polychrome design and for its role within this important Uniting Church complex. Founded in 1886, the hall is complementary in materials and detailing to the adjacent church buildings and appears intact apart from the addition of a porch on the east end and the alteration of glazing along the north and south sides.
