<p>Priscilla RYLAND has not yet been found in the 1841 Census however there is a probable entry for three of her children - Francis RYLAND (12), John RYLAND (11), and Agnes RYLAND (9) are listed with John RYLAND (38) schoolmaster and Charlotte RYLAND (46) at High Street, Camden Town, St Pancras, Marylebone, Middlesex. 12 other pupils with different surnames are listed at the same address. It is possible that Francis, John and Agnes, born Middlesex, are not the children of John and Charlotte RYLAND but pupils and/or relatives and the children of James and Priscilla RYLAND. They have not been found in the 1851 census when they were possibly already in Victoria with their mother.</p> <p>NOTE: James RYLAND died February 1841 - another reason why children may have been with relatives.</p>

Her father's occupation was shown as Wine Merchant.</p>

<p>16 Dec 1863 - Alexander James CAMPBELL purchased part of Block 1 Portion 24, Parish of Moolap for £700.0.0 from Priscilla RYLAND.</p> <p>The conveyance was registered 24 Dec 1863 [Book 135 No 100]</p> <p>Although it was reported that Rev A J CAMPBELL purchased Toorang from "Mr RYLAND" it is more likely that one of Priscilla RYLAND's sons negotiated the deal on her behalf and this is where the "Mr" has come into the history. Land Title records clearly show that it was [Mrs] Priscilla RYLAND who owned the property. The 1863/64 Shire of Bellarine Valuation Books also showed the owner as Mrs RYLAND.</p> <p>Rev A J CAMPBELL still owned the property in 1893/94 valuation books, however the occupant during that year changed from CAMPBELL to Mrs NICHOLSON</p>


