Statement of Significance

The Gables, 101 Princess Street, is a large, distinctive and externally intact example of the Federation villa. It has a double arched red brick entrance porch, with a verandah above giving access to a large attic storey. The garden palms, cypress hedge and fence are notable and contributory.
