Statement of Significance

25 Barry Street, a two storey late Victorian villa, underwent a major and somewhat extraordinary alteration in the Interwar period when the front verandah and balcony were radically altered and the house extended to the verandah line on the north side. Original elements which remain include the stucco architraves around doors and windows, the projecting bay beneath the front gable, the gable bargeboard, truss and cast iron and the slate roof and stuccoed chimneys. The garden contains some well established trees which are integral to the site's significance.
