



Statement of Significance

37 Ridgeway Avenue is significant as a representative and relatively intact example of the single storey timber Federation villa. Notable elements include the weatherboard of the facade, leadlight, the joinery of windows, doors and the verandah, the timber truss and barge boards of the front gable, the ripple iron awning of the projecting front bay and the corrugated iron, dormer vent and brick chimneys of the roof.
