Statement of Significance

The house at 51 Wellington Street is a distinctive and largely intact example of a Federation attic storeyed villa. Contributive elements include the leadlight and timber joinery, the red brick of the walls, the short square columns and brick piers to the verandah, the Marseilles tiles of the roof, the tall chimneys, and the attic balcony on the south elevation. The render of the gables and piers has been painted, but the chimneys remain unpainted.

The fence is a later addition.
