Statement of Significance

The house at 65 Wellington Street is a large and rather plain example of late Victorian Italianate design. A two storey asymmetrical villa, its render has been painted and an addition with a timber verandah has been made to its west side. Contributive elements include the rendered walls, the chimneys, the brackets of the eaves and columns of the entry porch and the joinery and glazing of the windows.
