Statement of Significance

The two storey former house at 67 Wellington Street, now converted to flats, is a distinctive and externally largely intact example of late Victorian design. Contributive elements include the Dutch gables, the unpainted strapwork to the chimneys and sections of the facade, the red brick of the walls, the widow's walk and slate tiles of the roof and the joinery and glazing of the windows.
