Statement of Significance

7 Fellows Street is of significance as a notable example of the Federation attic storeyed villa. Although some details have been lost, particularly in terms of the windows, it retains significant elements such as leadlight, halftimbering in gables, shingling around the attic storey, large turned timber brackets under the eaves of gables and Marseilles tiles.
