Statement of Significance

The house at 892 Glenferrie Road is significant as a large and relatively intact late Victorian Italianate villa. Of two storeys, with a verandah rising through both levels and a dominant tower, it is a vital element in the Glenferrie Road streetscape. Original elements include the richly ornamented and unpainted rendered walls, the cast iron decoration of the verandah, the urns of the parapet and the slate roof and rendered chimneys.
