Comment

Moyvane, 30 Walmer Street, is significant as an elegant and relatively intact late Victorian Italianate villa. Notable features include the cast iron of the verandah, rendered wall decoration, original joinery to windows and doors, slate roof with original iron finials and Italianate chimneys and original joinery to the gabled canopy at the entry. The garden also appears to retain many original elements
