The site at 1 Argyle Street is located on lot 40 of the Montrose Estate subdivision of 3 December, 1887. ^{1,2} Between 1907 and 1910, this block was owned by the Bank of New South Wales, but by 1911-12 it had been sold to William Kurzman, a gentleman, and he had this cottage built at that time.2 By 1918-19, the house had been sold to Mrs E. Looker of 5 Sharp Street, Chilwell. ² She leased the house to Richard McCrae, a labourer and later engine driver. ² The following year McRae purchased the property from Mrs Looker and he lived there until 1925-26, when the house was sold to F.W. Brand, building contractor.2 By 1928-29, the house was owned by Gordon W. Twitt, a labourer, and in 1932-33, Thomas W. Currie, a farmer from 46 Darlet Street, Horsham, was listed as the owner.2 He sold the house to Mrs Lily Hunt of Francis Street, Belmont, in 1938-39, and she leased it to Herbert McKellar Sheppard, a driver, between 1938-39 and 1943-44. ² By 1955-58, the house was leased to J.J.
