Other intact qualities include the weatherboard wall cladding, brick chimney, wide eaves and exposed rafters, timber framed casement windows arranged as a horizontal bank under the verandah (with the central light having a bowed sash) and as a projecting bay, and th gable ventilators. The house also makes a significant contribution to the single storey streetscape of mixed Edwardian, interwar Californian Bungalow and postwar homes. The house at 6 Francis Street is <i>historically</i> significant at a LOCAL level. It is associated with Gibson's subdivision of 1919-20. Overall, the house at 6 Francis Street is of LOCAL significance.
