History  The house at 2 McDonald Street was possibly built by John Spriggins, bricklayer, in 1888-89. At this time and until 1904-05, the house was addressed as Hovell Street. Spriggins let the house to Henry Doherty, a bus driver, in 1890-91, although by 892 and until 1893, Spriggins lived there. From 1893 until 1896, the house was leased to William Errey, a teacher. But om 1896 until 1900, Spriggins again occupied the house. He leased it to Patrick Gurrie, a labourer, in 1900, and he lived there until 1903. From 1903 until 1905, John Spriggins was again listed as the occupier, although in 1905 until 1907 Charles towke lived there. From 1907 until 1910, the house was occupied by Samuel Jacka, a labourer, and from 1910 until 1911, spriggins leased it to William Cole, a groom. Mrs Annie Baker was listed as the occupier from 1912 and she lived there until 921, when George Jordan, painter took up the lease. In 1921-22, Spriggins sold the house to Thomas Dyer, a chaff cutter and from 1924 until 1926 he leased it to John P. Calvert. From 1926-28 William Smith, a labourer, was the occupant. Dyer old the house in 1928 to Miss M. Taylor of Newtown.
