The single storey, asymmetrical, stone and timber Victorian house is characterised by a recessed hipped roof form, together with a minor hipped roof and concave return verandah that projects towards the street frontage and cides. The major roof forms are clad in early slate tiles, with the verandah clad in early galvanised corrugated ron. Three early, rendered brick chimneys adorn the roofline. Narrow overhangs are a feature of the eaves. The return verandah at the front and sides has been substantially altered with highly inappropriate c.1970s brick

History The site at 103 Mount Pleasant Road was owned by Morris Jacobs, a draper, as early as the 1870s. This house appears to ave been constructed in the early 1870s, possibly in 1873. Jacobs's land spanned 38 acres and included a vineyard. He wined a draper's shop in Moorabool Street, and in December 1870 he extended his drapery department by purchasing the djoining shop owned by Silas Harding. By the early 1890s, Jacobs's landholdings had increased to 58 acres. With the eath of Morris Jacobs around the turn of the century, Mrs E. Jacobs moved to Eastern Beach and leased the house firstly to William James Crother, a stock inspector, and then to Frederick Johnson, a dairyman. By 1921-22, the property was leased by Mrs Elizabeth Marshall. In 1924-25, Jacob's land was subdivided as the Jacob's Estate, and this house formed lot 167 of the subdivision which was sold to James Edward Christy, a textile worker. He lived there until the much reduced property was sold to Nellie Ellen Betts. In 1952, Wallace Edwin Meyer, a cabinet maker, and Jean Meyer, purchased the house. They lived there until at least 1960. Early and substantial cypress trees have recently be removed from the western side of the site.
