Statement of Cultural Significance         The building at 20 Regent Street is aesthetically significant at a LOCAL level. It demonstrates original design qualities of the interwar Art Deco style which include the cement rendered shopfront containing a striking pedimented parapet, paired square pilasters with geometric square and rectangular detailing, and the recessed title panel. The roof form, finish and ventilation stacks at the rear are also significant. The building also makes a significant contribution to the predominantly single storey streetscape.         The building at 20 Regent Street is historically significant at a LOCAL level. It has a strong association with the Country Fire Authority for over sixty years. The building is also historically significant at a LOCAL level as the work of Jack Freeland, early 20th century Geelong builder.         The building at 20 Regent Street is socially significant at a LOCAL level. It is recognised by the community as having public value for its associations with Belmont Fire Brigade. Through the shopfront recessed title panel with the name 'C.F.B.B. Belmont Fire Station 1930', the building also demonstrates a custom of decentralised suburban fire stations that is no longer in use.         Overall the former Belmont Fire Station at 20 Regent Street is of LOCAL significance.
