re: Honour Boards

The Honour Boards previously housed in our Public Hall (Mechanics Institute) are now firmly fixed on North Wall of Apollo Bay R.S.L. Building.

ONE 1914 - 1918 bearing the names of 101 men who enlisted from the area - 15 of whom were killed in action and 3 who died of wounds.

TWO 1939 - 1945 bearing the names of 193 men from the area - 15 of whom were killed or died as Prisoners of War, . also 16 women who joined the various forces.
The names 4 Vietnam Veterans have also been added.

Several small Boards taken from some of 7 little Schools which dotted the surrounding hills and bearing the names of ex pupils who enlisted, are held at the local Historical Museum, and one of Parisioners remains in the Apollo Bay Church of England Church.
