Comment: We are certain that there is or was a board for Lillimur for 1914-1918,
but have not been able to trace it. Lillimur is the site of the "Dardanelles" Park
which was erected in 1916 in remembrance of those who fought in the campaign.
This being so it would seem highly unusual that the same community would not commit
to an Honour Board, more especially as the Hall was named as the "Memorial Hall".
