

This data is summarised from a very comprehensive 1999 study made by members of the Buninyong RSL Sub-Branch, under the direction of President Paul Eklom. Original material is held in the Anzac House Library.

Description This Roll of Honour exists now only in a small photograph, the original being lost or destroyed some years ago. From the photo, it can be seen that it was about 160cm x 100cm, and consisted of a rectangular board with an arched roof. In the top section below the arch, are two crossed rifles. Below that in a scrolled arch is 'For King & Country', and below that 'Durham Lead State School'. The next line reads 'Roll of Honor' with '1914' and '19' to each side. Names are listed in two columns. All words and motifs appear to be in gold lettering and upper case. The board remembers those from the Durham Lead School who served in the Great War.

Location It is presently located in the Garibaldi Hall (formerly the school).

Condition Good.

Present Custodian Garibaldi Hall.

Probable Future Fairly safe, in a well kept hall, although the hall has been vandalised in the past.
