Description Square shaped hardwood board measuring 130cm x 100cm. At the top, an arched fascia panel with patterned cutouts sits forward of the back board. The fascia is supported on each side by two square section pillars. An insert in the back board reads 'For King and Country' within a waved scroll with 'Honor Roll 1914 - 1919'. Names are displayed within two columns in inserts in the back board. All words and motifs are in gold lettering and upper case. It was originally located in the Grenville Church, before the latter was moved to Sovereign Hill.

Location It is presently located in the Grenville Hall.

Condition Very good.

Present Custodian Grenville Hall (Golden Plains Shire).

Probable Future Reasonably secure. Hall is well used and well kept.
