## MILLBROOK METHODISTS

This data is summarised from a very comprehensive 1999 study made by members of the Buninyong RSL Sub-Branch, under the direction of President Paul Eklom. Original material is held in the Anzac House Library.

**Description** Colourful painting enclosed within a 100cm x 80cm frame. At the top of the painting is 'Honor Roll'. A thick bordered circle is next with the word 'Millbrook' around the top segment. Just above the circle is a collection of allied flags, and within it is a small church, with a scroll across it reading 'Lest We Forget'. To its left side is 'Methodist Church' and to the right 'Pride of Wallace Tent IOR'. Below the circle is 'July 27, 1917'. The names are listed within two columns. In the lower half of the painting, there are three drawings as follows. 'Anzacs at Pozieres' is to the outside of the left column; 'Sinking the Emden' is to the outside of the right column; and 'ANZAC' is at the bottom centre. Around the outside of the painting, are oval shaped photographs of all the men listed, except H. Wright, in clockwise order from the top right: Halford, J. White, Westcott, T. White, Findlow, Sandwith, Allen, Brown, Atkinson, Harris, Burrup, I. Campbell, M. Campbell. The painting lists those scholars from the Millbrook Church who served in WW1.

Location It is presently located at St Sidwell's Masonic Temple, Wallace.

Condition Good, some wear and fading. Photographs are only fair.

Present Custodian St Sidwell's Masonic Lodge.

Probable Future Safe, the lodge is active and the temple is in good condition.
