

NAPOLEONS SCHOOL

This data is summarised from a very comprehensive 1999 study made by members of the Buninyong RSL Sub-Branch, under the direction of President Paul Eklom. Original material is held in the Anzac House Library.

Description Hardwood timbered board measuring 190cm x 135cm with a gabled roof. At the top, a carved Rising Sun has been mounted and on each side is ‘Capio Lumen’. ‘Napoleons State School No 1072’ is below that and then ‘For God, King and Empire’. Name are in two columns either side of a central area, consisting at the top of a shield containing the words ‘In honor of our brave boys’. The shield has a crossed Union Jack and Red Ensign behind it. Below the shield is ‘Unveiled 12th Oct 1918’. Directly below those words is a glass cabinet, built to hold an Honour Book (which is currently kept in the Napoleons Historical Society building). An additional board has been added on each side of the main board to include the 1939 to 1945 veterans. At the bottom of the left outer board is ‘Made the Supreme Sacrifice’ and ‘ANZAC’ with a symbol which denotes those names on the main board who were ANZAC veterans. On the right outer board at the bottom is ‘Killed’. All words and motifs are in gold lettering and upper case.

Location It is presently located in the Napoleons Hall.

Condition Very good.

Present Custodian Napoleons Hall.

Probable Future Safe. Hall is well used and well kept.
