Description Hardwood board measuring 109cm x 80cm. It has a flat roof, with a raised gable roofed area above that. In this section are the words 'Roll of Honor', slightly arched. The square area below that has 'Scotsburn' at the top, with names in three columns. The centre column reads 'For God King & Country'. All words and motifs are in gold lettering and upper case. At the bottom of the right column, the board has a Vietnam heading.
