

EGERTON St Johns Church

This data is summarised from a very comprehensive 1999 study made by members of the Buninyong RSL Sub-Branch, under the direction of President Paul Eklom. Original material is held in the Anzac House Library.

Description Hardwood board measuring 150cm x 70cm with an arched roof. At the top is 'St John's Church Egerton' inside a clover shaped border. Below that in a reverse curve is 'Honor Roll'. The board is then divided into two bordered rectangular columns. At the top of the left column is 'Great' then '1914' and in the same area of the right column is 'War'. All words are in gold upper case lettering, with all names in the left hand column and none in the right. The board gives the impression of being unfinished.

Location It is presently located in the Mt Egerton Hall.

Condition Fair, some wear and scratches in areas and names are very faded.

Present Custodian Mt Egerton Hall.

Probable Future Reasonably safe. RSL would step in if hall was to close.
