

WARRENHEIP Methodist Sunday Sch

This data is summarised from a very comprehensive 1999 study made by members of the Buninyong RSL Sub-Branch, under the direction of President Paul Eklom. Original material is held in the Anzac House Library.

Description Hardwood and ply board measuring 130cm x 70cm with a steep gabled roof supported by two square pillars. Mounted to each pillar is a turned circular column rising to a balled point at the same height as the gable. The top of the gable is decorated by a rising wooden wave pattern. In the top section, the word 'Warrenheip' is in an arch shape with 'Methodist Sunday School' in two straight lines beneath it. Scrolled motifs decorate this section. Next is a panel with 'Honor Roll For God, King & Country' in two lines. Names are in two panelled columns below. All writing and motifs are in gold lettering and upper case. The board lists those from the Warrenheip Methodist Sunday School who served in WW1.

Location It is presently located at the Brown Hill Uniting Church, Ballarat.

Condition Very good.
