History

'Joseph Henry Abbott owned a tannery on the Sheepwash Creek (now demolished), a 'New Times' store in Pall Mall (part of Myer's Store) and this polychrome brick building. Though much altered beneath the modern verandah, and painted above, the pediment remains intact. Abbott was a Councillor for many years, Mayor on three occasions, and a Member of the Legislative Assembly¹.
