History

'This red-brick and cement church was erected in 1874 at a cost of £740. The trustees were so pleased with the result that they gave the architect, Mr. Creber, a gift of two guineas as a 'small acknowledgment of his excellent and satisfactory services.' Small it was! The interior was quite plain and no doubt to the taste of that strict branch of the Methodist Church. A pipe organ, acquired in 1900, squats attractively in the corner. The original Gothic window frames were replaced in 1956 with coloured glass. The adjacent hall was built in 1910¹.
