History

There were nine lodges of the Manchester Unity Independent Order of Oddfellows (M.U.I.O.O.F.) in Sandhurst in 1865. Two of them, the Loyal Bendigo and Loyal Heart of Friendship Lodge, were able to build this handsome hall at a cost of £2,000 at that time.

Along the frontage to Lyttleton Terrace were five shops. The main hall with gallery is on the first floor. The original red- brick and cement exterior has been painted over and many additions and alterations have been made in recent years. It is currently occupied by the Y.M.C.A. *The south side hall was expanded on 22-10-1955.*
