On the 1864 map a different shaped building is located to the Whitehall St front of the block. The 1877 plan shows a small building on the north end of the block fronting Whitehall Street. The 1895 MMBW plan shows this building but the 1910 plans shos the lot as vacant. There is a 1920's style wooden building on the site.</p>
